Distinguished Members of the Senate,

The Croatian World Congress (HSK) is an international, non-profit, non-partisan organization whose task it is to ensure the rights, interests, and position of Croatians and Croatian communities wherever they are endangered, denied, or violated, or eradicated. One of these threats to Croatians, and especially those in Bosnia-Herzegovina as the least numerous of the three ethnic groups in the country (15% of the population) is Islamic terrorism, which has been present in the country since the 1990s. Unfortunately, among the Islamist terrorists who trained in Bosnia and Herzegovina were also those who participated in the terrorist attacks of 9/11, one of the most tragic days in American history. Several are now to be found today in Guantanamo.

We have taken the liberty of attaching to this letter a recent speech by an independent representative in the Croatian Parliament, Mr. Nino Raspudic, who provides a detailed description of the development of Islamic terrorism in Bosnia and Herzegovina, its connections to the ruling Bosniac-Muslim establishment, and the threats it presents to Croatia and Croatian Christians in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

We hope this document will provide a more accurate understanding of the problem of Islamic terrorism and its ties to the Bosniac-Muslim leadership and lead to a more active approach on your part in addressing this danger. I would be glad if you forwarded this letter and document to other senators.
